Dues Check-Off Deduction<<<4% of dispatched hourly rate>>>is deducted from net wages.

(Carpenter Foreman, General Foreman and Superintendents are charged using the Journeyman Wage Rate)

No pension contributions are required on Apprentices during the first period.

**Benefit rates for Carpenter Helpers shall be 100% of the Area benefit rates for the appropriate agreement except that no Health and Welfare contribution will be required on the first 250 hours of employment for each Carpenter Helper, and no Retirement contribution will be required for the first 500 hours of employment for each Carpenter Helper.
