# SCHOLARSHIP

### IS YOUR STUDENT ELIGIBLE?

- ◆ Must be unmarried, and a child, adopted child, stepchild or grandchild of a NWCUP/PNWRCC member\*
- ◆ Member must have voting rights in his/her local union (not be in arrears)

### WHAT MUST AN APPLICANT DO TO QUALIFY?

- ◆ Have a high school diploma, or be a 2021 graduating senior, or have a GED
- ◆ Plan to attend a trade school, community college, or four year college/university **full time**
- ◆ Fill out the official scholarship application
- ◆ Submit official transcripts
- ◆ Generate a FAFSA report
- ◆ Get letters of recommendation
- ◆ Complete questionnaire
- ◆ Write an essay
- ◆ Submit all documents by **FRIDAY, MARCH 26, 2021**
