(Dues are deducted from net pay and submitted to the Trust with benefit contributions)

Travel and Subsistence: When an employee covered by this agreement lives more than 50 miles away from the jobsite he/she is dispatched to, per diem will be paid. Per Diem will be paid in the amount of \$100.00 per day. If the employer is working under the Wyoming Building Trades Agreement it is understood the Wyoming Building Trades per diem rate shall apply. When food and lodging which are agreeable to the Union is provided by the Employer at no cost to the employee, Travel Expense and/or Subsistence will be waived.
